July Penny Quilting & Half-price Binding Special

Many of you have been heard to lament, "I have a whole stack of quilt tops done and just need to get them quilted before I make any more!" Well, here is your chance! For any quilts brought in during the month of July, the rate for edge to edge machine quilting will be .01 per square inch! (Regular rate is .015 - .03) Get your quilts done for 1/3 less! The \$25 set-up fee will still apply. Choose from 5 specially selected patterns.

If it's the binding part that is holding you up, you'll jump at the chance to have your finished quilt bound for half the regular price! You bring us your yardage, and we'll make and sew on the binding for .15 per inch. (Regular price is .30 per inch.) For example, a 100 x 100 quilt will cost you just \$60 to bind!

Hooked on Thangles Nite

Make perfect triangles the fast and easy way with Thangles! Thangles are very easy to use. You never have to cut triangles or use 7/8" math, or square up every piece. All you do is cut straight grain strips. We will be starting a new project using Thangles every quarter and will meet on the 3rd Monday of the month. **We will begin working on the beautiful Autumn Leaves Quilt in July!** This quilt is very fat quarter friendly. There is no class fee, but you will have to purchase the pattern and enough Thangles to complete the project.

Twisting Pinwheels

See the adorable sample in the shop! Joanne Hubbard will be teaching you how to make this intriguing quilt, which can be made in two different sizes. The class will be on Saturday, June 26th from 11:00 – 4:00. Bring a lunch or be prepared to order out, as we will be breaking for lunch. You should be able to complete the quilt top that day. This class is recommended for confident beginners on up. The plastic template is required, but it includes the pattern. The cost of the class is \$15. Fabric not included. Some simple work is required ahead of time. Please call for details. Space is still available.

Scrap Therapy!

Scrap Therapy addresses the stash problem by teaching quilters how to turn their mounds of beautiful fabric scraps into usable sizes...which are then ready to create quilts and other projects with custom-designed patterns. If you have not already purchased the pattern, call or stop in to see what pre-cutting is required. Aunt Philly's Toothbrush Rug OVAL

We are constantly getting inquiries for another class on Aunt Philly's. The "Toothbrush Rug" is made from torn strips of fabric and a modified toothbrush. These rugs are quick to make and **require no sewing** and have a fast tearing technique which shows you how to tear all your fabric in just minutes. BLOCK OF THE MONTH

Celebrate the Season

From The City Stitcher, who gave us Quilted Village! This quilt explores different frayed edge techniques in the geometric quilt blocks as well as applique. There are nine sections, or months, with 2 or 3 blocks worked each month. Machine appliqué is used to sew areas that are not frayed and some paper foundation piecing is included, with the seams frayed & showing on the right side of the quilt. Directions are also given for traditional applique. Finished quilt measures 54.5" x 46.5" and all nine block patterns are included with the complete set, which must be purchased prior to the class. Fabric kits will be available. The class will meet on the 3rd Saturday of each month from 10 am – 12 pm. However, the first class will meet on Saturday, October 23rd (the 4th Saturday) due to a conflict with our fall shop hop. Call now and get yourself signed up! Fall will be here before we know it!

Elegant Garden Hand Appliqué

We are still accepting sign ups for the Elegant Garden block of the month by Laundry Basket Quilts. In this series, you will learn beginning basics of needle turn appliqué, such as making templates, placing the pattern, and a variety of stitches. You will also learn how to make circles the easy way! There are a total of 24 block patterns in this series. You will be required to purchase at least your first 6 patterns prior to starting the class, which are \$5 each. The class fee will be \$5 per session. Each person will be picking out or bringing her own fabric for this project. We will be running the class as a continuous block of the month, so jump in any time. The class meets once per month on the 4th Tuesday from 10:00 am – 12:00 pm. A few new people have just joined, so new members will fit right in. Please let us know ASAP if you are interested so we have enough patterns!
